

## Our CREATIVE Curriculum in the Summer Term in Little Griffins

# This term our topic is...Look Out, Look Out.

As part of our whole-school topic “Look Out, Look Out”, Little Griffins will be learning about “Pirates”; who they are, what they did, where they went and how they lived.

We will explore what a pirate was and how they belonged to a “crew” and the different role within them. We will look at pirate ships and their materials, creating our own models using different materials and techniques. We will label parts of a pirate ship and understand why they were important.

We will look at treasure maps and how “X” marks the spot. We will make our own treasure maps and pirate flags sing pictures and symbols and use them to play games. Through play, we will continue to develop our number skills through counting and coins, comparing sets of treasure, balancing and weighing using direct comparisons.

In expressive arts children will learn and join in with sea shanty songs, responding through movement and creative expression. Children will experience making shakers and drums. The children will begin to develop simple engineering skills by designing and building bridges and testing how thing work.

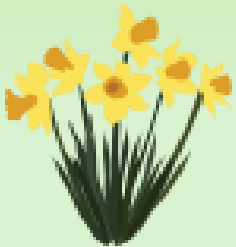
